

- ✓ N^o 1. Native Silver from Brattfors Iron Mine in the Province Wermanland. In the very Iron Load a round concavity was discovered containing massive lumps native Silver of this specimens
- ✓ N^o 2. A fine Kile from the same place and mine, 100 Wht of this Kile doe yield 50 proct Silver and 8 proct Bismuth.
- ✓ N^o 3. Native gold with yellow Mondick discovered 1738 in the Province Smaland In Tonkioppings Gouvernement et Al, Sida Parish.
- ✓ N^o 4. Yellow Mondick from the same mine doe containe 3 1/2 ounces gold.
- ✓ N^o 5. Silver oar from Sahlberg in the Province Wermanland contains 16 ounces Silver 100 Wht.
- ✓ N^o 6. Silver oar from Sahlberg Schimmer oar Called contains 20 ounces Silver 100 Wht.
- ✓ N^o 7. Copper oar from Lapponia and Schangli, wary 160 Swedish miles from Northbotm contains 50 proct Copper and 3 ounces Silver.
