After that we stept into Santa Maria della Vittoria, where the Enfignes hang which were taken in Germany, to wit, the Crosse Keyes and the Miter, with the motto Exterpentur. Against this Church stands the famous Fountaine of the great Moyses striking the Rock, out of which gusheth water; The two Lions on each fide were brought from before the  $R_{\theta}$ unda. The Popes granaryes are hard by.
